

Math Academy 1 Spring Final

Format

The test will consist of about 50 multiple-choice questions. These will be online, so you will be able to see your score multiple times before turning in your test.

Partners

You will work with a partner, and turn in one test between the two of you. You may choose your partner. If your partner's grade in the class is significantly higher than yours, your score on the final will be reduced to account for the fact that your partner likely contributed to the final significantly more than you did.

Types of Questions

Some questions will involve procedures and calculations, and these will be simpler than or comparable to questions on chapter tests. However, there will be an emphasis on conceptual understanding, reasoning, and application.

Notes

You may use the book, a Chromebook, and unlimited notes on the final. This includes printed or online notes, charts, quizzes, reviews, tests, other assignments, your own handwritten notes, etc.

Value

The final is worth two chapter tests (200 points) and will be curved.

Timing

The official time for the final is 7:40 to 9:40. If you feel you may want additional time, you and your partner may come in as early as 7:00.
